

CALCULATING UNION DUES AT TAX TIME 2017

HOW TO CALCULATE UNION DUES PAID FOR 2017:

1. Multiply your *Gross Wages* by 4% (.04)
2. Multiply your total hours worked by 4% of your total fringe package:

Journeyman: \$.88

APPRENTICES

5th Year Apprentice: \$.88

4th Year Apprentice: \$.88

3rd Year Apprentice: \$.82

2nd Year Apprentice: \$.72

1st Year Apprentice: \$.57

3. Add amounts of 4% and fringes to your monthly union dues:

Journeyman: \$42.00 Apprentice: \$32.00

EXAMPLE:

John made \$40,000 in gross wages ($\$40,000 \times 4\% = \$1,600.00$). John a journeyman, worked 1,500 hours ($1,500 \times \$.88 = \$1,320.00$). His monthly dues $\$42.00 \times 12 = \504.00 . ($\$1,600 + \$1,320.00 + \$504.00 = \$3,424.00$ Total Dues).
